Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 10, 2020

Eric Roelofs – Mr. Roelofs asked if Fridays could be in-person in order to maximize the in-person instruction.

Closing of Public Session.

Dr. Sargent responded by asking parents to follow up with school principals and the district’s technology department to resolve virtual learning issues. She reminded the public that the district had Board, parent and student input on the return to school plan and association leadership participated in at least five of the committee meetings held over the summer. Pandemic response teams at the school level are meeting this week or on Monday and that is an opportunity for teachers to bring additional concerns forward to their principal. The principals know that whatever they feel they are not able to address at their building level can be followed up on at the administrative level. She said she would take into consideration the idea of having Friday instruction in-person as the attendance and health data continue to be monitored for the region.

Mr. Berrios added that we all need to work in cooperation and not in competition and the health and safety of the students and staff are taken into consideration every day.

Mrs. Golderer concurred with Mr. Berrios but asked if the district had any issues providing PPE to the schools or technology equipment to the students and staff.

Dr. Sargent responded that the pandemic response teams are meeting at the school level this week and on Monday. She was not aware of serious gaps in the areas noted but there are plans in place to get chromebooks to staff and students.

Mr. Neglia asked how often Dr. Sargent meets with the school principals to get the feedback on the items that the teachers need to support them.

Dr. Sargent responded by saying that the principals meet with her at least twice a month and that is in addition to her regular walkthroughs and phone calls with a quick question.
